



Call For Submissions

LEARNing Landscapes is an open access online education journal supported by LEARN (Leading English Education and Resource Network). Published in the autumn and spring of each year, it attempts to make links between theory and practice and is built upon the principles of partnership, collaboration, inclusion, and attention to multiple perspectives and voices. The material in each publication shares and showcases leading educational ideas, research and practices in Quebec and beyond by including articles, interviews, visual representations, arts-informed and multi-media texts, etcetera, that we hope will inspire teachers, administrators, and other educators to reflect upon and develop innovative possibilities within their own practices.

Submissions

We are welcoming submissions to be considered for publication in our seventh issue (autumn 2010). The theme is **Poetry and Education: Possibilities and Practices**. We are interested in submissions that embrace inclusive notions and aesthetic approaches to poetry teaching and poetic inquiry in research. Texts that illustrate best classroom practices at any level or in any discipline, and/or ways researchers use poetry to understand and represent research are of interest. We also encourage submissions that address compelling stories of poetry in education, innovative practices, and/or the impact poetry can have on

students and other audiences. The manuscripts should be between 4000-6000 words (teachers/practitioners may write as few as 2000 words, students should write between 500-1000 words). Submissions of poetry may vary in length, but some contextualization and/or explication of the process is encouraged. Visuals and other forms of representation are most welcome. In addition, our text-based manuscript guidelines request that work should be formatted according to APA guidelines. All submissions should include an abstract of not more than 75 words and a biography of 50-75 words accompanied by a digital photograph. Any graphics should be in JPEG or GIF format, with articles sent as attachments to mstewart@learnquebec.ca in WORD format.

Deadline for submission is May 1, 2010.
